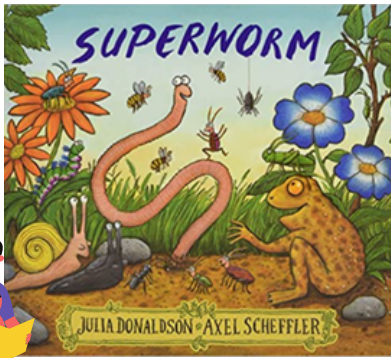

Activity Idea - Tiny Tots Sensory play with spaghetti

Babies usually begin to crawl
between 6 and 10 months,
although some may skip the
crawling phase altogether and go
straight to pulling up, cruising and
walking. Help your baby get ready
for crawling by giving him lots of
supervised tummy time.

Activity Idea - Older Explorers Threading

Brilliant for helping little
hands practice and
develop skills they need
as they grow older.

You can use string or
pipe cleaners with pasta
or make a giant wiggly
worm from painted
kitchen roll tubes!
