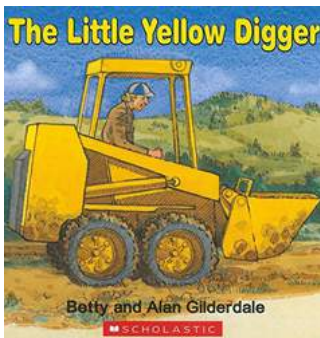

Activity Idea - Tiny Tots Digging for treasure in jelly!

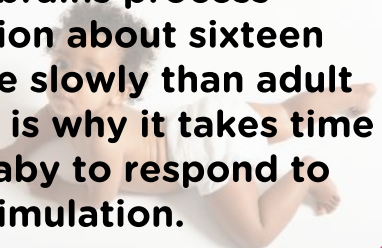
Don't forget to put out
