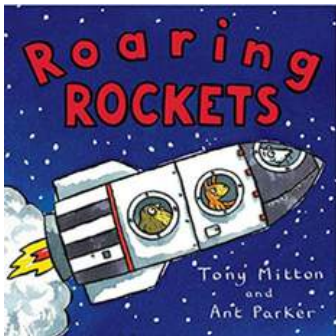

Vegetable oil

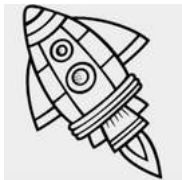

## Activity Idea - Tiny Tots Black and white images



Very young babies can see in black and white, as they get older, red is the next colour they see. Search for images on the internet to print and cut out. Make your own sensory book for baby to look at or put pictures on the wall for baby to see.

## Did you know...

Babies begin to perceive their own emotional experience by the parent exaggerating the expression of the baby and then the baby in turn imitating the expression of the parent. Parents need to wait patiently for this imitation to occur!

## Activity Idea - Older Explorers Make a rocket



Wrap white paper around a kitchen roll tube.

Cut out a 2" radius circle from different coloured paper and wrap it around to make a cone.

Glue the cone on top of the toilet paper roll.

Cut out triangles and strips of paper to make fins and flames for your rocket.

## Discovery time
