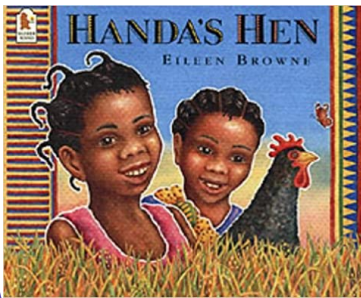

Activity Idea - Tiny Tots Cooling Sensory play
