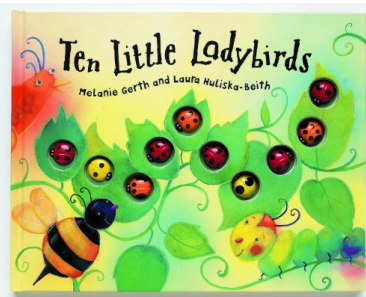

Activity Idea - Tiny Tots Music and Rhythm

Activity Idea - Older Explorers

Counting Ladybird Pebbles



Using flat pebbles, red, black and white paint, you can have fun with your little one decorating pebbles to look like ladybirds. Count the spots as you paint them onto a wing....Can your little one do the same on the opposite wing?

Discovery time

One to One Counting

All you need are some pots, cut out numbers and some dried pasta.



Count the items into the pot: one, two, three...with the corresponding number. Always supervise your child, as small items like pasta can be a choking hazard.
