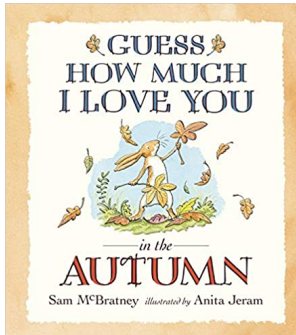

## Activity Idea - Older Explorers An Autumn Bug Hunt



Talk about the insects that live outside, then ask your child to draw the insects they'd like to find. Help them by describing it for example, 'how many legs?' or 'what colour is it?'. Once your list is complete, go out in your garden or go for a walk and tick the boxes when you find each one!



## Activity Idea - Tiny Tots Making Marks

As your child explores writing or drawing, comment on what they're doing, instead of how pretty it is or what it looks like.

'You've made a red mark'.
