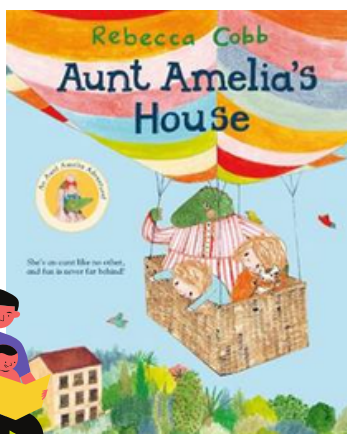

Activity Idea - Older Explorers Sorting games

Thinking about the 'tidying up' in
the story, makes us think of
sorting games.

All you need are the following:
Cupcake cases /plastic bowls
Coloured pom poms or different
shaped painted pasta.

Using giant tweezers adds another
physical element to this game.



Did you know...

Sorting games help children develop
EXECUTIVE FUNCTION SKILLS,
important brain skills that help with
memory, attention and problem-
solving. These skills do not develop
on their own, children need to
participate in activities that promote
these skills.

Activity Idea - Tiny Tots Name, Name, Name!



It's really important to
repetitively name objects,
shapes, colours and
numbers when you chat
with your baby.

This helps language
development and the
problem solving skills
needed to play the
activities mentioned
on this sheet.
