

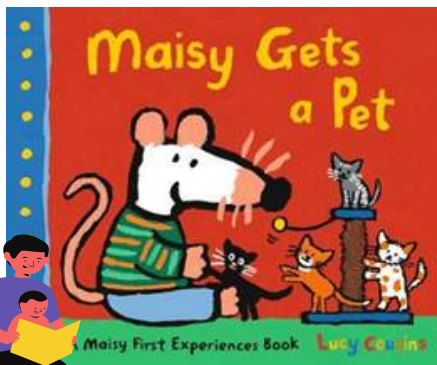

Activity Idea - Older Explorers Imagination: Going to the Vet

Help your child set up the animal hospital.

What do you need?

- Teddies /dolls
- Bandage
- Blankets
- Paper, scissors and tape to make a vet's hat.
