Activity Idea - Older Explorers Playing Shopkeepers

Re-use safe, empty packaging like toothpaste boxes, clean plastic bottles e.g. washing up bottles, tea bag boxes and cereal boxes to create an environmentally friendly, plastic free pretend shop.



Did you know...

Activity Idea - Tiny Tots Sensory Bottles

An empty, clean plastic bottle can be recycled into a sensory bottle, just by adding water and food colouring.

Alternatively, add dry ingredients like some cereal or rice and seal the lid securely.
