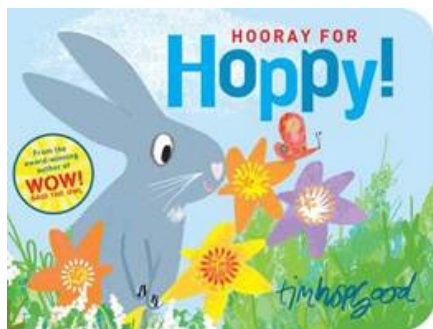

Activity Idea - Tiny Tots Little Lamb Handprints



You will need:
Paint - black and white
Paper
A pen and paintbrush



Use the paintbrush to help your child paint
their fingers and thumb black and their palm
white. Press hand down firmly onto the paper.
Lift the hand up. Turn the paper upside down.
Use the pen (or fingers) to draw some ears, eyes
and a tail!

Activity Idea - Older Explorers Folded Paper Painting



You will need:
Coloured paint
Paper
A paintbrush



Fold a piece of paper in half. Unfold. Paint your
design or pattern on one side of the paper. Fold
the paper over and press down to transfer the
paint. Unfold the paper to see your full design!
You could make a flower, a butterfly, a rainbow
and more!
