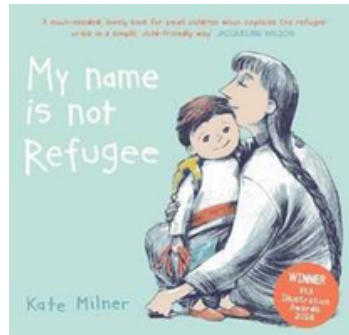

Brain-building happens when you and your little one are interacting with each other. It's about taking a cue from them, and reacting to what they're doing. You could think of it like a game of tennis - going back and forth between the two of you.

Activity Idea - Tiny Tots Sensory Rainbow Oats

You will need;
porridge oats, food dye, zipper food bags, paper towels and water



Place 1 cup of oats into zipper bag with 1 teaspoon of the food dye and a quarter of a cup of water. Mix together until completely covered. Pour onto paper towels and leave somewhere to dry.
