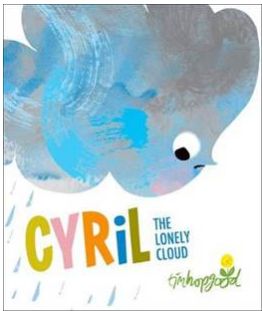

- Pour a spoonful of rice into the tube
- Place on the lid and seal with tape

Activity Idea - Older Explorers Water Play

Water play has many benefits including helping to improve motor skills and creativity! You could try:

- Washing toys with flannels and soapy water
- Painting the fence using spray bottles with water
- Sinking and floating items in water
- Sea creatures with blue food colouring in water
- Duck/Boat Races (in a bowl or the bath)
