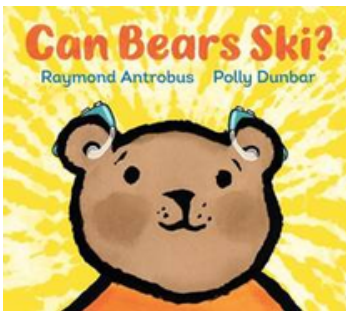

Activity Idea - Tiny Tots Teddy Bears Picnic

Set out a blanket or rug on the floor.

Gather some teddies and toys.

Bring out some plastic plates and cups.

Settle down with your child and encourage play.

Talk about what you can see and hear.



Sing a song.

Tell the teddies a story.



Your picnic doesn't have to be pretend!

You could sit outside with some food
and drink.

Activity Idea - Older Explorers



Paper Plate Bear

Paint your paper plate

Cut out 2 small circles to
form the ears and a larger
circle for the nose.

Glue the ears to the top of
the plate and the nose in
the middle.

Glue on the googly eyes
Paint on a black nose and
mouth!

You will need:
Brown & black paint
Paper plate
A paintbrush
Googly eyes
Glue & scissors
Brown paper
