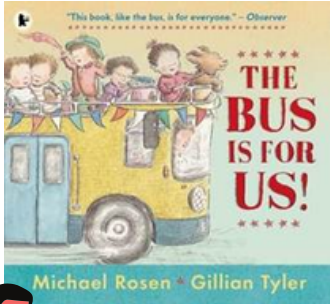

Activity Idea - Tiny Tots A ride on a bus or a train!

Activity Idea - Older Explorers Cardboard Box Transport

Collect big cardboard boxes next time you go food shopping.

You don't need a degree in creativity - just your child's imagination. Be on hand to provide help with the tricky bits i.e. cutting out shapes.



Discovery time

Next time you are out, look at different types of transport and talk about how many wheels they have.

You could use language like more than or less than e.g. "Does a car have more wheels than a bike?"
