I Spy Colours

Go outside to your garden or an outside space. Look around and play 'I spy colours', where one person says "I spy with my little eye, something blue." Your child has to guess what it is. Try it with lots of different colours too.

Colour Sorting

Collect different coloured items from around your house. This could include toys, craft materials, clothes and kitchen utensils. Ask your child to sort them into different colours and talk about what they have done.

Rainbows

Paint or draw a rainbow. Talk about each colour as you use it. You might like to display this in your window.

Toilet Roll Owl

This recycled craft uses a cardboard tube as the body. You can paint it brown or get creative with a "rainbow owl" theme.



Tissue Paper Rainbow Mobile

Mirror the rainbow the owl sees by attaching strips of tissue paper in every colour to a cardboard cloud or plate.



Paper Plate Owl

Use a paper plate for the body and cut out triangles for the ears and beak. Children can paint the plate brown or choose a "wow" colour from the book.

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
