Outdoor Activities

Log Pile House: Use natural materials (twigs, pinecones, leaves) found in your garden or the park to build a safe little house for a snake or a mouse.

Scavenger Hunt: Ask your child to act like a woodland investigator and find items in nature: a "prickly" leaf, a "smooth" stone, or a feather.

Mud Kitchen Potions: Set up a bowl of water, small containers, spoons, mud, leaves, grass and flower petals for your child to mix up their own "poisonous warts" and other forest potions.

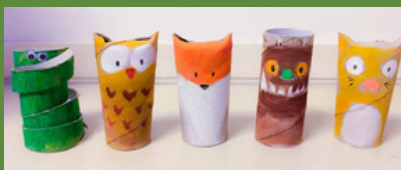

Play dough

Use the recipe below to make
your own playdough then build
your own Gruffalo animals!

1 minute play dough recipe

What do you need?

- 1/2 cup of salt
- 1 cup of flour
- 1 tablespoon of cream of tartar (find it in most shops with the baking ingredients)
- 1 tablespoon of oil
- 1 cup of boiling water (from the kettle)



How do you do it?

Put all the dry ingredients in a bowl and then
mix with the hot water.

Adults should handle the hot
water



For a change:

Add food colouring to the boiling water to make
different coloured dough!
Add glitter for extra sparkle!

Together you & your child can now shape,
squeeze, roll or cut the dough

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
